WHAT IS PUPPETS IN THE GREEN MOUNTAINS (PGM)?

A biennial international festival of Puppet Theater with a 27 year history that takes place in Windham County, Vermont presented by Sandglass Theater.

- 7+ puppetry ensembles from around the world, representing places such as Europe, Asia, Latin America, Australia and the Middle East.
- Over a dozen performances across numerous regional venues.
- Performances and hands-on workshops that appeal to a diverse audience, with opportunities for children, adults, educators, local students, parents, activists, as well as puppeteers and arts presenters from around the world.
- Deep exchange and connection between local community members and artists from across the US and abroad.
- Networking and artistic development for puppetry professionals, hobbyists and the puppet-curious
- Community-based discussions that enable the artistry to inspire engagement with issues facing our community, our region, and our country.



WHY IS PGM IMPORTANT?

- PGM is a crossroads of invigorating arts and community exchange that creates meaningful connections among audiences and performers.
- PGM brings people together to share meaningful performance and dialogue experiences that foster cultural exchange and understanding.
- PGM spurs our region's arts economy and brings a significant volume of cultural tourism to southern Vermont, establishing our region as a creative hub and destination at an international level
- PGM develops and celebrates local arts networks through forums and stimulating entertainment to both children and adults.
- PGM is one of only a handful of international puppet festivals in the country and is the longest continually running festival in the United States.
- Sandglass board and staff act as cultural ambassadors for our region, and represent the US among international festival circuits.
- The festival has developed best practices around accessibility services including ASL interpreted performances, inclusive sensory-friendly touch tours, social stories, tiered ticket prices, and remote access through live streams.

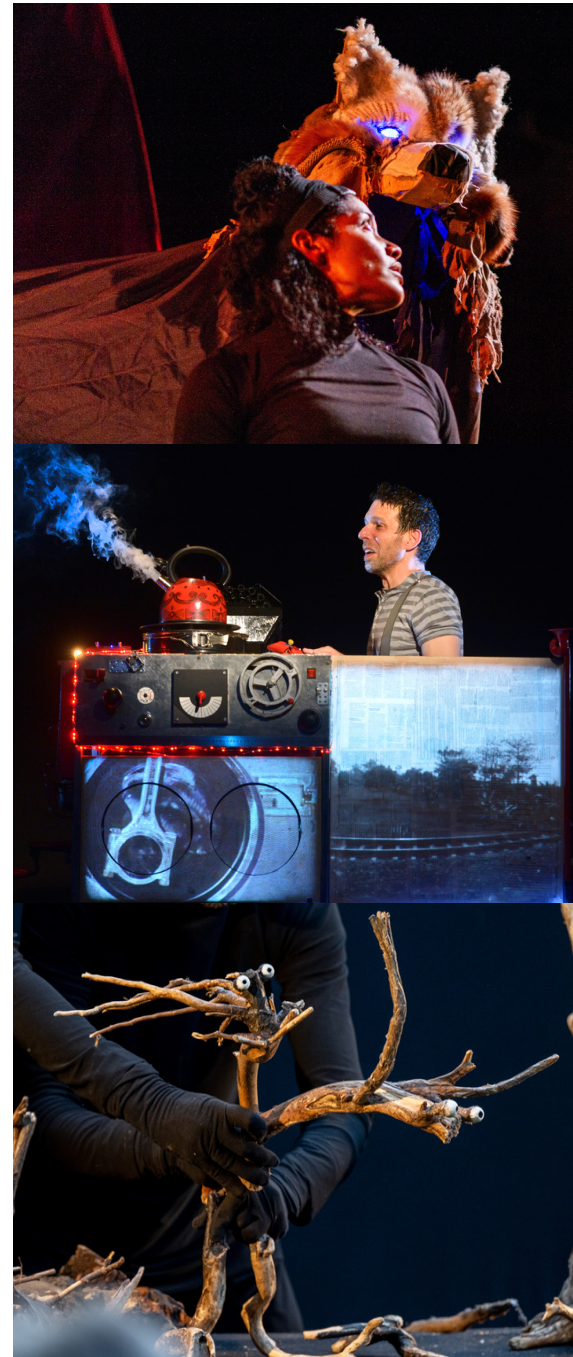
